Ideas to try

- Plan a route inside your house or outside in the garden.

- Write creative clues to discover where the prize is hidden i.e. Mum likes to cook up tasty treats here (the kitchen)
- Nature Scavenger Hunt inspired by the trees, animals, and plants outside
- Eggs-ercise Hunt fun activities to do once you find your prize i.e. skip round the garden, hop like a bunny, touch your toes.
