When purchasing your pumpkin make sure:

 Visually appealing, evenly a deep orange. Shape that appeals to you. Most pumpkins have a flat spot, due to being grown on the ground you can use it as part of your design

- Free from cuts, soft spots, bruises. The flesh should feel hard, and not give easily.
- Make sure the stem is attached

Store it carefully. A fresh-picked pumpkin is best kept in a dry place. Pumpkins will keep for months in a cool, dry, low humidity environment.

Remember: If you like roasted or baked pumpkin seeds, you can save the seeds from any pumpkin!
